### New London Elementary Schools

#### Early Childhood and 4K

- 24 pack crayons
  - 4 glue sticks
  - 1 bottle glue
  - Washable markers
  - Crayola watercolor paints
  - 2 folders (labeled)
  - Backpack (large enough to hold a folder; no mini-backpacks please; labeled on outside)
  - Water bottle (labeled)-send daily
  - Oversized art shirt (in a gallon Ziploc bag with name on it)
  - Change of clothes (pants, shirt, underwear, socks--no shorts; please place in large Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name)
  - Prepackaged bag or box of healthy snacks (store bought) to share and be replenished throughout the year (animal crackers, fish crackers, granola bars, pretzels, cereal, graham crackers, etc.)
  - Family Picture for our "Celebrate Family" board

#### Kindergarten - 1st Grade

- Plastic pencil box
    - Pencils
    - Extra eraser (large pink)
    - 24 pack of crayons
    - 4 glue sticks
    - Scissors
    - Wide markers (classic colors)
  - 3 folders
  - 2 notebooks
  - 1"- 1½ inch 3 ring binder (not a trapper keeper)
  - Headphones (to be kept at school)
  - Backpack (please label on the outside)
  - Water bottle (labeled)-send daily
  - Gym shoes to be left at school
  - Art shirt (in a gallon Ziploc bag with name on it)
  - Extra set of clothes for accidents or messes (in a gallon ziploc bag with name written on it)
  - Students will need to bring personal and pre wrapped snacks
- \*Chromebooks will be provided for classroom use, but not sent home.

#### 2nd grade- 4th grade

- Plastic pencil box
    - Pencils/erasers
    - Hand held pencil sharpener with cover
    - Colored pencils
    - 2 glue sticks
    - Glue bottle
    - Scissors
    - Crayons
    - Optional: Markers
  - 6 folders and notebooks \* matching if possible otherwise we will label by class
  - 1"- 1½ inch 3 ring binder (not a trapper keeper)
  - 4 3-Pronged folders for interactive notebooks
  - Headphones
  - Backpack
  - Water bottle (labeled)-send daily
  - Post-it Notes
  - Gym shoes to be left at school
  - Art shirt to be left at school
  - Students will need to bring personal and pre wrapped snacks

## New London Intermediate and Middle School

### 5th grade - 8th grade

- Plastic pencil box

### 9th grade - 12th grade

- Pencils/erasers

- Wireless/portable mouse (if preferred)
- Safety glasses for any Technical Education and/or Science courses
